Grand Master Ian A. Cyrus, Founder of the IKMAF

Grandmaster Cyrus has studied the martial arts for over 39 years. He holds a 9th Degree Black Belt in Hapkido from the World Kido Federation, only the second non-Korean ever to attain this rank, and the youngest ever at age 50. He holds a 9th degree black belt in Choson Kwon Bup and is the 7th successor and lineage holder of the system. He is the founder of Hapkido Yu Shin Kwan, recognized and supported by the World Kido Federation and the Sin Moo Hapkido Federation. Grandmaster Cyrus also holds a 7th degree black belt in Taekwondo and is a licensed Doctor of Traditional Oriental Medicine. He is also a student of Hapkido Founder, Dojunim Ji Han Jae.

Grandmaster Cyrus, a native of Trinidad & Tobago has been involved in the martial arts for over 38 years. He has promoted well over 300 practitioners to various dan levels many of whom are masters themselves. His experiences as a U.S. Marine, FBI Special Agent, and educational pursuits has led to him to develop a view of the martial arts that is practical, yet based on sound currently available scientific concepts and principles while maintain tradition.

Grandmaster Crudup began his formal training 40 years ago in Shotokan Karate at the American Youth Academy Karate Club in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania under the direction of Sensei Ernest Paramore and earned his Black Belt at the age of 14. He was also promoted to Black Belt in Moo Duk Kwan Tae Kwon Do by Master Oscar Young Sul in 1975. Additionally, he earned Black Belts in Chang Moo Kwan Tae Kwon Do under Grand Master Ozzie Wright, Jr. in 1979 and Chung Do Kwan Tae Kwon Do under Grand Master James L. Mitchell in 1979. He was a top-rated tournament fighter from the mid-70s to early-80s in the Tri-State Area (Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware) well-known for his tremendous kicking ability. He won numerous championships during this period to include the World Bi-Centennial Karate Games in 1976 and the Peter Urban American Cup in 1977 and 1979. Some of his classic match ups were against east coast tournaments greats such as Marty Manuel, Rodney Nobles and Henry Grant. He also enjoyed a brief kickboxing career fighting in the Professional Karate Association (PKA) before entering the United States Air Force in March 1983. He spent over 15 years in assignments throughout the Pacific theater to include tours in Guam, Korea, Japan and Okinawa before returning to the United States in 2001. Grandmaster Crudup made a special tournament appearance in 2005 and captured the Black Belt Sparring Grand Championship at the Kombat Classic in Waldorf, Maryland.

Some of Grandmaster Crudup's other accomplishments include a 7th degree Black Belt in Kyo-Jutsu Karate under Professor Sayfullaah Al-Amriykiy and Soke Nat McBride, direct disciples of the legendary Great Grandmaster Dr. Moses Powell. He was promoted to 9th degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do by Grandmaster Furman Marshall (Simba Dojang, Washington DC) in January 2010. He was awarded the title of Doju (Keeper of the Way) of Song Do Kwan Kong Soo Do and 10th degree Black Belt by the World Korean Martial Arts Union, Chairman Chang Hwa Park. He was the first American to receive 9th Dan recognition by both the Global Taekwon-do Federation-International and the Malaysian Global Taekwon-do Federation from Founder and President, Professor Dr. Dato' Sabree Salleh, direct student of Grandmaster Choi Hong Hi and Grandmaster Park Jung Tae. Grandmaster Crudup was also appointed by Dr. Salleh as International Director of the Global Taekwon-do Federation. Additionally he received an honorary Doctorate of Philosophy Degree and Professorship in Martial Arts Science from the World Academy of Martial Arts Philosophy and Science.

Grandmaster Crudup has been inducted into numerous martial arts halls of fame to include Great Grand Master Aaron Banks' World Professional Martial Arts Organization Hall of Fame, Action Martial Arts Magazine Hall of Fame, American Federation of Martial Arts Hall of Fame, Budo International Hall of Fame, Cosmopolitan Florida Hall of Fame, Gary Alexander's International Association of Martial Arts Hall of Fame, Kuroshi-Do Martial Arts Hall of Fame, Latin-American Martial Arts Hall of Fame, London International Martial Arts Hall of Fame, North American Federation of Martial Arts Hall of Fame, Southeastern Martial Arts Association Hall of

Fame, United States Head of Family Martial Arts Association Hall of Honor, United States Martial Arts Hall of Fame, Universal Martial Arts Association Hall of Fame, World Head of Family Sokeship Council Hall of Fame, World Karate Union Hall of Fame and the World Martial Arts Hall of Fame

Grandmaster Crudup serves as a Senior Executive Advisory Board member for the United States Head of Family Martial Arts Association and President of the World Organizer of Martial Arts (WOMA USA) New Jersey Chapter. He is the founder and President of the Universal Song Do Kwan Alliance, headquartered in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The goal of the Alliance is to build a cadre of martial arts instructors and develop programs throughout the city in churches and community centers to offer training and mentorship opportunities to inner-city youth at affordable costs.

Grandmaster Crudup retired from the Air Force with the rank of Chief Master Sergeant in August 2009 and now works as a Federal Wage and Hour Investigator with the United States Department of Labor. He was presented the "Men Making a Difference Award for 2007" by Congressman Chaka Fattah. He holds two associate degrees from the Community College of the Air Force, a Bachelors Degree in Business and Management from the University of Maryland and a Masters Degree in Human Resources Management from Chapman University.

Dwayne McClellan Sensei

Dwayne McClellan Sensei, Chief Instructor at Iaido Seishinkan Dojo currently holds the rank of 3rd Degree Black Belt (Sandan) in Muso Shinden Ryu Iaido.

McClellan Sensei began his study of Iaido in 1996 under the tutelage and guidance of David Goldberg Sensei, 4th Dan Iaido and 5th Dan Aikido.

McClellan Sensei also studies with the North American San Shin Kai which is under the direction of Roger Wehrhahn Shihan, 6th Dan Iaido. Through Wehrhahn Shihan, McClellan was fortunate enough to had study under the late Grandmaster Mitsuzuka Takeshi Sensei. McClellan also studies with the late grandmaster's son, Mitsuzuka Munehiro Sensei, 7th Dan Iaido.



Grand Master Keith McKinley

Keith R. McKinley began his martial arts training in 1973 at the age of 9 under the tutelage of Grandmaster James L. Mitchell. Master McKinley earned his Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do in 1979 at the age of 15. In 1985, Master McKinley began training with Korean Martial Arts Grandmaster Ian A. Cyrus; earning Black Belt Dan rankings from the World Tae Kwon Do Federation (WTF). Today, Master McKinley studies Hapkido and grappling arts under the direction of the International Korean Martial Arts Federation. Master McKinley currently holds the rank of 5th degree Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do from the IKMAF(www.ikmaf.com) and 7th degree Black Belt from the Universal Song Do Kwan Alliance (www.songdokwan.ning.com). As an instructor

of the martial arts, Master McKinley served as an assistant instructor from 1981 through 1985 at James Mitchell's Chung Do Kwan Tae Kwon School of Self Defense. From 1985 through 1995; he was the founder and Chief Instructor of the West Philadelphia Tae Kwon Do Academy and while there; he promoted numerous students to the rank of Black Belt. During these years Master McKinley trained and promoted several Black Belts who are now Master instructors of their own schools. During Mr. Master McKinley's tenure as a sport karate competitor (1981-1993), he was consistently regionally and nationally ranked in the Black Belt fighting division. As a sport karate coach, Master McKinley continues to train sport karate athletes who become national champions under his guidance. As a citizen, Master McKinley was born and raised in the City of Philadelphia. He graduated from Temple University in 1986 with a Bachelor's degree in Political Science. He attended Temple University School of Law and received his law degree in 1989. Master McKinley is currently a practicing attorney and he is the sole proprietor of The Law Offices of Keith R. McKinley. He currently resides in Delaware County Pennsylvania where he is the proud father of two young children. He is also an active member of Tenth Presbyterian Church in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
